This policy confirms how any personal data you provide to ORA Holdings Limited when you interact with us directly and through this website is used. In this privacy notice we will refer to ourselves as 'we', 'us' or 'our'.

We take the privacy, including the security, of personal information we hold about you seriously. This privacy notice is designed to inform you about how we collect personal information about you and how we use that personal information. You should read this privacy notice carefully so that you know and can understand why and how we use the personal information we collect and hold about you.

We do not have a Data Protection Officer, but if you have any questions about this privacy notice or issues arising from it then you should contact us via the contact details above.

INFORMATION COLLECTED

ORA Holdings Limited does not offer any transactional services via this website. Providing personal or otherwise confidential information on this website (e.g. for Materials Request, E-mail Alerts, etc.) is completely optional. The information collected from visitors to this site will be used solely for the purpose stated. ORA Holdings Limited will never sell, trade, give away, or in any other way disseminate your personal information or e-mail address to a third party.

For each visitor to our website, our web server automatically recognises only the consumer's domain name, but not the e-mail address. We aggregate information on what pages consumers access or visit to develop traffic reports.

The information we collect is used for internal review and is then discarded, and/or used to improve the content of our website, customise the content and/or layout of our site for each individual visitor, and is not shared with other organisations for commercial purposes.

COOKIES

We use cookies to assist our traffic measuring software, so you are not counted more than once. Cookies are not used for any other purpose whatsoever.

AD SERVERS

We do not partner with or have special relationships with any ad server companies, as ORA Holdings Limited does not offer advertising opportunities via this website.

SECURITY

With respect to security: We have appropriate security measures in place in our physical facilities to protect against the loss, misuse or alteration of information that we have collected about your visit to our site. No personal or otherwise confidential information about you is maintained on these web servers.

KEY DEFINITIONS

The key terms that we use throughout this privacy notice are defined below, for ease:

DATA CONTROLLER: Under UK data protection law, this is the organisation or person responsible for deciding how personal information is collected and stored and how it is used.

DATA PROCESSOR: A Data Controller may appoint another organisation or person to carry out certain tasks in relation to the personal information on behalf of, and on the written instructions of, the Data Controller. (This might be the hosting of a site containing personal data, for example, or providing an email marketing service that facilitates mass distribution of marketing material to a Data Controller's customer-base.)

DATA SUBJECT: You, being the identifiable person to which the Personal Information relates.

PERSONAL INFORMATION: in this privacy notice we refer to your personal data as 'personal information'. 'Personal information' means any information from which a living individual can be identified. It does not apply to information which has been anonymised.

SPECIAL INFORMATION: Certain very sensitive personal information requires extra protection under data protection law. Sensitive data includes information relating to health, racial and ethnic origin, political opinions, religious and similar beliefs, trade union membership, sex life and sexual orientation and includes genetic information and biometric information.

DETAILS OF PERSONAL INFORMATION WHICH WE COLLECT AND HOLD ABOUT YOU

Set out below are the general categories and in each case the types of personal information which we collect, use and hold about you:

Domain Name: This is the domain you have used to view our website.

Website, Device and Technical Information: This is information about your use of our website and technical data which we collect (including your IP address, the type of browser you are using and the version, the operating system you are using, details about the time zone and location settings on the device and other information we receive about your device).

DETAILS OF SPECIAL INFORMATION WHICH WE COLLECT AND HOLD ABOUT YOU

Special information is explained above. We do not collect or hold any special information about you.

We do not collect information from you relating to criminal convictions or offences.

DETAILS OF HOW AND WHY WE USE PERSONAL INFORMATION

We are only able to use your personal information for certain legal reasons set out in data protection law. There are legal reasons under data protection law other than those listed below, but in most cases, we will use your personal information for the following legal reasons:

Legitimate Interests Reason: this is where the use of your personal information is necessary for our (or a third party's) legitimate interests, so long as that legitimate interest does not override your fundamental rights, freedoms or interests.

Our use of your information is explained above.

DETAILS OF HOW LONG WE WILL HOLD YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION

We will only hold your personal data for as long as is necessary. How long is necessary will depend upon the purposes for which we collected the personal information and whether we are under any legal obligation to keep the personal information.

YOUR RIGHTS UNDER DATA PROTECTION LAW

Under data protection laws you have certain rights in relation to your Personal Information. As explained above, we do not hold Personal Information, we only hold your domain name and log your usage of our website for development purposes.

MARKETING

You will not receive marketing from us. We do not pass your personal information on to any third parties for marketing purposes.

COMPLAINTS

If you wish to raise any queries or make a complaint in respect of our handling or use of your Personal Information, please do contact us using the information at the beginning of this Privacy Policy so that we have the opportunity to discuss this with you and to take steps to resolve the position.
